<u>Speaker:</u> Sarah Heath of United Way on Homelessness in Orange County:

A total of 7,322 persons experiencing homelessness were counted during the Orange County 2024 POINT IN TIME count. This one-to-one count took place with a record turnout of 1,251 volunteers over three days, from Tuesday, January 23, 2024, through Thursday, January 25, 2024, covering 800 square miles of Orange County.

Who are these homeless people? How long have they been homeless? What landed them on the street and what can help them get off the street?



Sarah Heath is a Community Engagement Manager for United to End Homelessness, an initiative of the United Way of Orange County.

Sarah is also an Ordained Elder in the United Methodist Church. Originally from Canada, she earned her Master of Divinity degree from Duke Divinity School in 2005. Sarah has been a public speaker for over 20 years. She is also the author of two books, <u>What's Your</u> <u>Story?</u> and <u>The Authenticity Challenge.</u> Sarah is also listed in Orange COunty's Top 100 Influencers for 2019.
